



Adoptive Parent(s) Agreement Please read the following:

Your electronic signature on your Adoption Contract will be your guarantee to us that you have read and understood the following Agreement.

- I agree to provide care from this day forward to my new pet. This includes adequate food, water, exercise, shelter, veterinary care, and lots of love.
 - I agree never to sell, trade, or surrender the pet to any agency without giving prior notice to: One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue
 - I agree that One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue will have first option of reclaiming the pet.
 - I agree that the adoption fee is non-refundable and there is no reimbursement if the adoption does not work out unless agreed upon by One Paw at a Time.
 - I agree that all expenses incurred after I take possession of pet will be my sole responsibility and One Paw at a Time is released of any and all liabilities whether financially or other.
 - Adoption fees can vary between £285 and £500 dependent on origin and age. This is non-refundable and is payable on the day of adoption unless agreed by the rescue and adopter. This is not payment for the dog but to put towards funding to help other dogs needing our help.
 - The need for insurance is essential as the rescue will not be held responsible for vet bills after adoption has taken place.
 - We don't allow any of our dogs adopted to be taken on to be placed to live outside unless the dog agreed to be adopted has been an outdoor dog already.
 - We do not re home dogs to be used for Guarding, breeding or anything else other than a family pet.
 - We won't place any of our dogs in a home where they will be left alone for longer than 6 hours a day at any one time.
 - The new owners must agree to have the adoptive dog either neutered or spayed within 3 months age permitted of course, and this must be done at our own vets (details can be provided). If the adoptive pet isn't neutered at our vets with agreement with us the rescue then we would need to see proof from the vets that the surgery was done at and contact details of the vets. (Applies to Unneutered/Spayed dogs only)
 - New owners must advise us immediately of any change in circumstances which would mean that the dog is not getting the attention/need that the dog deserves
 - New owners must inform the rescue of any change of address.
- As a small foster based rescue, who care about each dog we help to rehome, we love to stay in touch with all our adopters to ensure our One Paw dogs are happy and settled.

We may arrange a home visit after the adoption at your convenience.

We at One Paw have a no KILL POLICY and in putting the dogs FIRST, as it should be, we endeavour to get the very best homes for every one of the dogs that come through our rescue, it is only under extreme circumstances that we would consider getting a dog euthanized, and then the decision must be agreed by us and the vets and the present owner.

- We try our best to give as much information we have on each dog we re-home but this cannot be guaranteed.
- You will ensure the dog wears a collar carrying our/your name and telephone number at all times for identification purposes
- You will ensure the dog wears **harness** at all times when taken outside of the property
- To allow a representative of One Paw at a Time Dog Rescue to visit the dog and, if in their opinion the dogs' welfare needs or the conditions of the contract are not being met, they may repossess the dog.
- To inform One Paw Rescue as soon as possible when the dog dies and where required, the circumstances.
- To inform One Paw Rescue within 7 days if the adopter moves house.

I /We understand that One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue will accept no responsibility as to the description, condition, health and temperament of the dog adopted and give no warranty of any kind expressed or implied.

The dog is believed to be in good health except where specific conditions have been pre advised to us in advance which we in turn will make known to the adopter.

One Paw Dog Rescue will accept no liability for expenses incurred arising from illness or injury developed subsequent to an adoption.

The responsibility for paying for the costs, including treatments from the day of adoption will be the sole responsibility of the adopter unless otherwise agreed with One Paw At a Time Dog Rescue.

Any known information concerning the habits and past history of the dog is passed on to the adopter by One Paw At a Time Dog Rescue in good faith and this information has been based on statements made by the dog's previous guardian/s.

There is no guarantee of its reliability. One Paw Dog Rescue will not accept liability for any consequences whatsoever resulting from events attributable to failure to give information or transmission of wrong information.

I/We agree to One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue holding our personal details on file for the duration of the adoption.

One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue will not share any details with third parties unless required by law or to assist in investigations concerning the dog's welfare.

Once adopter has signed this agreement, you have accepted One Paw At A Time Dog Rescue not be responsible for any outcome that's out of our control, unless we have stated any known issues we are made aware of within the dogs four-week assessment period.
